How Often Do They Need Changing? The current estimate is that an EV car battery will last from between 10 to 20 years before needing to be replaced. Having said this, needing to pay over £8,000 for a new Tesla Model S battery every 10-20 years would likely encourage most to stick to their petrol and diesel engine vehicles.

When should a car battery be replaced?

At the very least, you will be able to estimate your battery's life as well as plan for an uninterrupted replacement. Automobile experts recommend that you replace the battery around this time (4-5 years), or if you notice any powering glitches. Timely replacement is required to prevent further damage to your car's electrical system.
