

# How to repair the stripped screws of the battery panel

How to fix stripped threads on a side battery terminal?

So, I ordered a new top screen as well as a new case to fix it. Though, when I got the screws off with the official screwdrivers, I stripped one (The upper right triangular one). Now, no matter what I do, I can't remove it. I tried using glue, a rubber band etc. but the screw hasn't even moved. I'm really wondering what I should do here.

For the less stripped one, it looks like using a rubber band should work. When doing this you need to do it slowly and it usually takes some time and a lot of tries.. For the other one, try to use a needle or something similar and see if you can get rid of the stripped away metal and then try the rubber band.. If that doesn't work, the best thing I can think of now is to take a screwdriver ...
