What is battery recycling?

Battery recycling is a recycling activity that aims to reduce the number of batteries being disposed as municipal solid waste. Batteries contain a number of heavy metals and toxic chemicals and disposing of them by the same process as regular household waste has raised concerns over soil contamination and water pollution.

Where can I recycle a battery?

There should be a collection point at the premises for 'portable' batteries. These include AAA, AA and 9V batteries, battery packs, button batteries and rechargeable batteries, which can be found in a huge range of products. Basically, all batteries apart from those designed for vehicles or industrial use can be dropped off for recycling this way.

Why is battery recycling important?

While reducing the amount of pollutants being released through disposal through the uses of landfill and incineration, battery recycling can facilitate the release of harmful materials from batteries to both the environment and the workers recycling batteries. Most types of batteries can be recycled.

Can you recycle a phone battery?

If you can't remove the battery from the phone, then you can dispose of the entire device with commercial WEEE recycling. With any laptops for personal use, you can dispose of their old batteries in a battery recycling bin found in most medium and large shops that sell batteries.

Can you recycle a leaking battery?

Whether you have a leaking battery or some used ones that are still intact, recycling batteries has been more straightforward than ever before, preventing them from going to landfill, as they once would have. Lead-acid batteries are broken down in a hammer mill. Here, the acid will be drained off so as to separate the lead and the plastic.

How do you dispose of a leaking battery?

To dispose of leaky batteries, you should first put them in a clear plastic bag and seal it to prevent anyone from coming into direct contact with these hazardous materials. Then you can dispose of the leaking batteries the same as any old batteries - in a battery recycling bin at a supermarket, recycling centre, or via collection.
