A bit more fundamental explanation from the battery level: A cell has a minimum voltage threshold it absolutely cannot cross. As the battery gets low, very low, a large current draw will cause the cell to cross the threshold. So you have energy available, but not much power. The lower the battery charge gets, the less current it can provide.
