

How much does it cost to drive an EV in France?

Like the UK, some French cities, including Paris, Rouen, Lyon and Bordeaux enforce low-emissions zones. While your EV will be free to drive within them it must still display a Crit'air sticker confirming its emissions status. These cost EUR3.77 and must be ordered in advance (allow at least two weeks) from the official website. Tolls.

Are IONITY chargers cheaper in France or the UK?

As well as being plentiful, chargers in France are generally cheaper than in the UK. I used Ionity chargers a lot and its standard rate on the Continent is around 50p/kWh rather than 76p in the UK. Even the most expensive motorway devices were no more than 58p/kWh without a mobility subscription.
