### How is South Ossetia governed?

South Ossetia's legislative body is the unicameral parliament, which consists of 34 members who are elected by popular vote for five years in a mixed system of 17 single-member constituencies and 17 delegates elected through proportional representation (article 57).

#### Who controls South Ossetian AO?

Currently, its territory is controlled by the breakaway Republic of South Ossetia. The population of the South Ossetian AO consisted mostly of ethnic Ossetians, who made up roughly 66% of the 100,000 people living there in 1989, and Georgians, who constituted a further 29% of the population as of 1989.

### How many people live in South Ossetia?

It has an officially stated population of just over 56,500 people(2022),who live in an area of 3,900 square kilometres (1,500 sq mi),with 33,000 living in the capital city,Tskhinvali. As of 2024,only five members of the United Nations (UN) recognise South Ossetia as a sovereign state - Russia,Venezuela,Nicaragua,Nauru,and Syria.

#### What is the political status of South Ossetia?

The political status of South Ossetia is a central issue of the Georgian-Ossetian conflict and Georgia-Russia relations. The Georgian constitution designates the area as "the former autonomous district of South Ossetia",in reference to the South Ossetian Autonomous Oblast disbanded in 1990.

### Who is the president of South Ossetia?

President: Alan GagloevGagloev became president of South Ossetia following the April 2022 presidential elections. One of his first acts was to suspend a referendum on unification with Russia until consultations with Moscow were complete. During his campaign he said his priority would be the development of the region's economy.

#### Who financed the socio-economic development program of South Ossetia?

The socio-economic development program of South Ossetia for the 2022-2025 period is financed by Russia. The Aim of the program is for South Ossetia to reach the socio-economic indicators of the North Caucasus Federal District in 2025.
