

What to do if you drill a hole in the rooftop solar panel

How do you install solar panels on a roof?

To install the mounting brackets, holes are drilled into the roof and usually into the rafters, and these holes are made for the lag bolts that secure the racking system upon which your solar panels are mounted. Depending on the type of material your roof is made from, the size and depth of the holes will vary.
